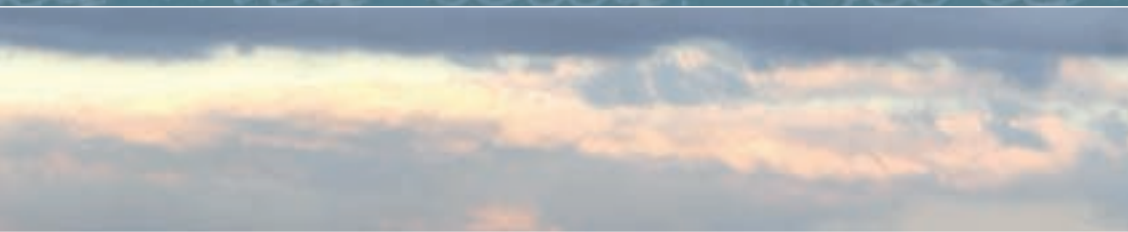

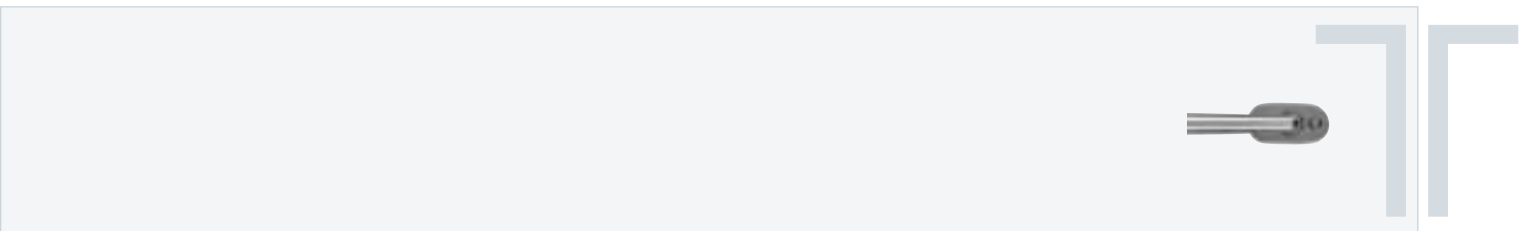


There's no morning that doesn't begin with looking out the window.

The Germanic peoples called it *augatora*.

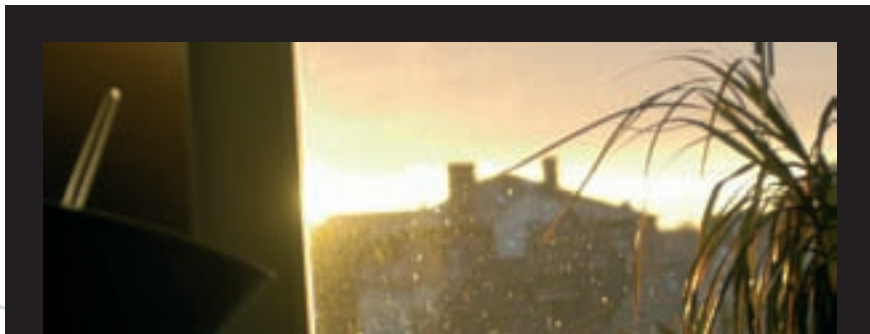
Old High German = *Augentor*. In a nutshell: Thoughts go out the window, the feet go through the door.

In drafty Icelandic language, the idea of *Vindauga* allegedly still resides in this word. In the drafty, old Icelandic = das *Windauga* (the wind's eye).

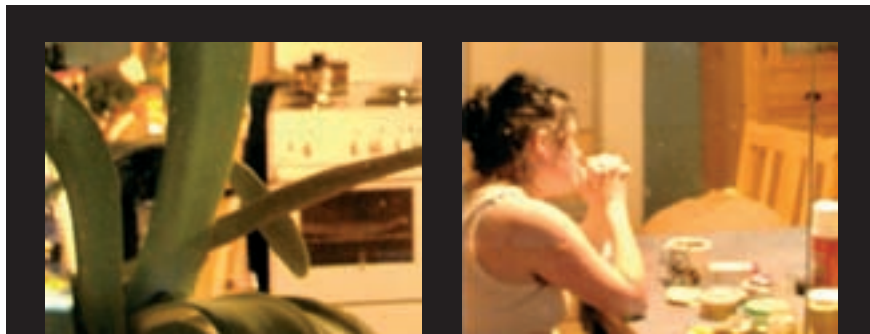

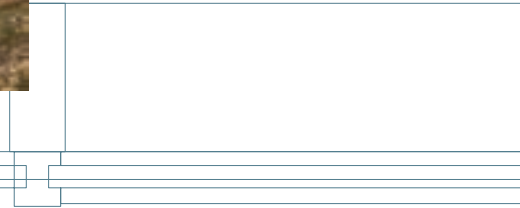


Houses are

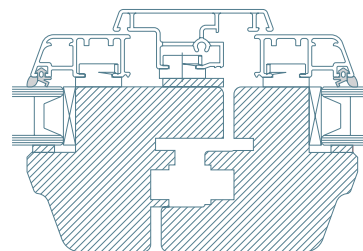
Window section



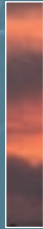
in post and beam facades
